*Historic Flemington is Hunterdon County, NJ's beautiful county seat, where there's something for everyone. We invite you to stroll our tree-lined streets and admire our charming buildings – 65% of our borough is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Flemington has always been a fascinating crossroads for shopping, agriculture, and the arts. It has grown in recent years as a regional destination for more than 400 businesses, including 50 restaurants, boutiques, country stores, national outlets, bookstores, and art galleries. Flemington boasts several antique stores on Main Street and others nestled in unique spaces on side streets waiting to be discovered. Flemington is a boutique shoppers' dream with great finds at small-town prices and friendly, business owners.*

*Fun in Flemington is measured by almost weekly special events. Flemington's convenient free parking lots and long picturesque streets make it a favorite destination for seasonal festivals, including Flemington Car Shows, Salsa Night, Flemington Fine Artisans Show, Rail Fest, Flemington Flea Market, Flemington Corn, Tomato and Beer Festival, Central Jersey Jazz Fest, and Holiday Lights. In addition, Flemington's Main Street is host to the Hunterdon Holiday Parade, Memorial Day Parade, and annual (and adorable) Halloween Parade. Flemington's also hosts several races, including the Turkey Trot 5K, Girls on the Run 5K, and Main Street Half Marathon, which winds (and climbs) through bucolic Hunterdon from Clinton to Flemington. Bikers love Hunterdon's rolling hills and pastoral roads, and Flemington is the perfect place to stop, stretch your legs, and dine and browse the shops.
